## **Soft Skills Intro**

While employers look for candidates with skills and training needed to perform a specific job (hard skills), they're also interested in hiring employees who have developed soft skills that are important to getting work completed in a team environment. They often include communication and listening abilities, as well as empathy and work ethic.
